Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in your sight, O Lord, my rock and my redeemer. Psalm 19:13-14 (esv)

The writer of Proverbs also gives us insight for our prayer life: "Two things I ask of you; deny them not to me before I die: 8 Remove far from me falsehood and lying; give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with the food that is needful for me, 9 lest I be full and deny you and say, "Who is the Lord?" or lest I be poor and steal and profane the name of my God. Proverbs 30:7-9 (esv)

So in the midst of the blessing, when you are praising the name of the Lord, remember to ask the Lord to keep you.
