There is no danger of the individual saint being overlooked amidst the multitude of supplicants who daily and hourly present their various petitions, for an infinite mind is capable of paying the same attention to millions, as if only one individual were seeking its attention.

So too the lack of appropriate language, the inability to give expression to the deepest longing of the soul–will not jeopardize our prayers, for "Before they call I will answer; while they are yet speaking I will hear." (Isaiah 65.24 esv)"
