



**Family preparation for congregational worship on September 18, 2016**

**Our Scripture-Jude 1.3-7 (ESV):**

Beloved, although I was very eager to write to you about our common salvation, I found it necessary to write appealing to you to contend for the faith that was once for all delivered to the saints. <sup>4</sup>For certain people have crept in unnoticed who long ago were designated for this condemnation, ungodly people, who pervert the grace of our God into sensuality and deny our only Master and Lord, Jesus Christ. <sup>5</sup>Now I want to remind you, although you once fully knew it, that Jesus, who saved a people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed those who did not believe. <sup>6</sup>And the angels who did not stay within their own position of authority, but left their proper dwelling, he has kept in eternal chains under gloomy darkness until the judgment of the great day— <sup>7</sup>just as Sodom and Gomorrah and the surrounding cities, which likewise indulged in sexual immorality and pursued unnatural desire, serve as an example by undergoing a punishment of eternal fire.

**Discuss:**

1. Why did Jude write this letter?
2. Why did Jude change the subject of his letter?
3. How does Jude describe ungodly people?

**Prayer:** Praise the Lord that Salvation is a gift. Praise the Lord that His work is honorable and glorious. Ask God to search your heart and cleanse you from your sin. Pray for a greater commitment to the Lord. Pray for the Daniel & Heather Boyd family as they minister in Holland. Ask the Lord to lead your life. Ask the Lord for opportunities to share the gospel this week. Ask the Lord who He would have you invite to church this coming Sunday.
